

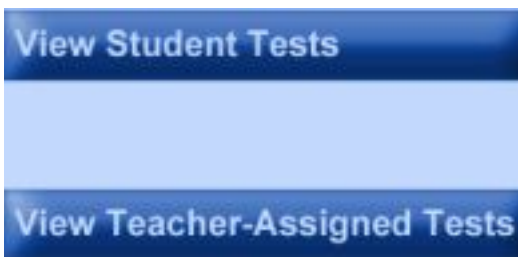

3. There are 2 types of tests available:



**Student Tests** are practice tests that have been created by the state. There should be at least one test for each subject area. In most cases, there will be more. There are tests for each subject area. Each test contains approximately 8 questions.

**Teacher-Assigned Tests** are tests created by the county, school, or teacher and assigned to students. These tests vary in their length and scope. Teachers use the different tests in various ways, some being utilized at school while some are assigned for home practice. You should receive information from your child's teacher regarding which teacher-assigned tests your child should be taking at home.

4. Click either type of test. Then click on the desired subject and/or test. Then click on the Take Test button.
